Suffolk Learning Link offers a chance for people in the public and voluntary sectors to improve skills and gain a City and Guilds qualification in:

- **English**
- **Maths**
- **English skills – ESOL (for those whose first language isn't English).**

Courses vary in length based on what you want or need to learn. You can choose where and when they take place. All courses lead to a valuable national qualification.

If you have care responsibilities, or if transport is an issue, we may be able to help towards your costs.

To take advantage you must work in Suffolk and not have a level 2 qualification in the subject you wish to take.

When you join you will get free benefits.

- We will arrange a course personalised to your needs in English, maths or ESOL with a local learning provider at a venue convenient to you, possibly your workplace.
- Your training can be in small groups or maybe on a one-to-one basis.
- Short courses can be set up to get you your qualification quickly.
- This can include entry level 3, level 1, level 2 and part qualifications.
- Each person will receive a brief case containing a learning resource pack and useful information about local opportunities.

On successful completion of your course and qualification, we are able to offer a limited number of people assistance to go on to further learning. This will include:

- Referral to an information advice and guidance session by a skilled and qualified person. This will inform you about opportunities available.
- **Up to £100 towards the cost of a course or training.** This could include individual tuition or coaching, course fees for a local college or learning provider or other agreed training. Conditions apply.

Available to May 2007 while funds last.
